Hatfield Village Watch - How to Join

Hatfield Village Watch is registered with the Neighbourhood Watch - you can receive texts directly to your phone with the latest information from the police or from Village Watch coordinators. The objective is to assist in making and keeping the area as a safe place to live and work. Some members have already assisted the police with crime detection, without direct involvement.

There are monthly HVW meetings, these are open to all members, sometimes with guests such as local locksmiths, the police or DMBC officers – we attend local PACT (Police and Community Together) meetings
